The class will be patterned loosely after SNG 3120, Lyric Writing, that I teach at Belmont University. This will be a hands on course with students writing several lyrics before, during, and after their time in Ireland. We will briefly explore the songwriting traditions in Ireland with a more focused look at contemporary singer/songwriters. The class will also provide a look at the business side of songwriting in Ireland with a field trip to IMRO, Irish Musical Rights Organization.
